2008-2009 HIGHLY QUALIFIED TEACHER DATA

Federal law, *No Child Left Behind (NCLB)*, requires each school district and each individual school within the district to provide the public with information regarding teacher quality including degrees attained, certification, and qualifications in the content area(s) in which they are assigned. Requirements for the designation “Highly Qualified Teacher” are established in the NCLB law.

All teachers employed by the Lisbon School Department are currently entitled to teach under Maine’s strict certification requirements. All of Lisbon’s teachers have college degrees and several have advanced degrees. In addition, every teacher continues his or her own learning by setting professional goals and collecting evidence of having made progress on attaining those goals. In addition, *No Child Left Behind* requires that teachers identified as “Highly Qualified” must demonstrate subject-matter knowledge in each content area that s/he teaches.
