

TOBACCO USE AND POSSESSION

In order to promote the health and safety of all students and staff and to promote the cleanliness of all facilities, the Lisbon School Committee prohibits smoking and the use of all other tobacco products in school buildings, facilities and on school buses during school-sponsored events and at all other times on school grounds by all persons, including students and employees.

In addition, students are further prohibited from possessing, selling, distributing or dispensing tobacco products in school buildings, facilities and on school grounds and buses during school-sponsored events and at all other times.

Employees and all other persons are also strictly prohibited, under law and the Lisbon School Committee's policy, from selling, distributing or in any way dispensing tobacco products to students.
