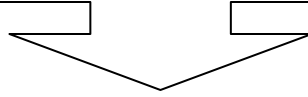


ANNUAL CURRICULUM REVISION CYCLE

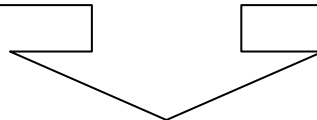
Implement the Curriculum Unit

Teach the knowledge, concepts, and skills embedded within the curriculum unit



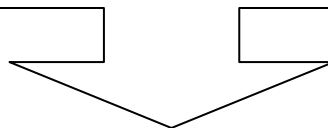
Give the Common Assessment Associated with the Unit

Prepare students for unit's common assessment
(End-of-Unit or CLAS, if it exists);
Give students the common assessment



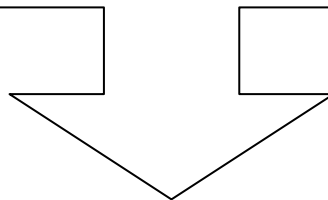
Double Score/ Score Common Assessment

- If a CLAS assessment, be sure to double score common assessment with colleagues (minimum of 20%)
- If an End-of-Unit assessment, try to score as many as possible with colleagues




Use Data to Inform Instruction, Make Curriculum Changes & Revise the Common Assessment

- Determine changes to instruction (strategy, content, timing, etc.) and/or resources *using data from all teachers' student scores*
- Make changes to the curriculum unit and/or the unit's assessment where necessary *using data from all teachers' student scores*
- replacement assessment must be given in at least one classroom (**NOTE:** this pilot is in addition to the assessment specified on the CLAS Blueprint)




ANNUAL CURRICULUM REVISION CYCLE (continued)

For Curriculum Units in Literacy or Math in Grades 3-8 and 11
Make sure the unit's content and skills are aligned with the Grade Level Expectations (GLEs) for reading and math



Forward All Implemented Curriculum and Assessments

- Send curriculum unit and common assessment (if one currently exists) with changes and recommendations to the curriculum office for review by the appropriate content area review team
 - If there are no changes, note this and send curriculum unit and common assessment (if there is one) to the curriculum office
 - If the unit includes a CLAS assessment, include the CLAS assessment scoring sheet and student work with the unit and assessment

Content Area Review Feedback and Changes

- The appropriate Content Area Review Team will review the proposed changes and suggest revisions to the unit and/or assessment
 - The grade level or content area team will be notified of the revisions
 - Changes will be reflected on the curriculum website as soon as possible
